

APPLICATION FORM FOR WOOD AWARDS IRELAND

Wood Awards Ireland is open to architects, engineers, designer, woodworkers and other practitioners throughout Ireland – north and south – who incorporate wood as the inherent medium in submitted projects. WAI is also open to Irish practitioners based overseas who complete innovative work for Irish and international markets.

Sustainable timber sourcing and usage is a key element of the project with emphasis on energy efficiency. Timber used must be sourced in sustainably managed forests and conform to the EU Timber Regulation (No 995/2010).

Entries are accepted in six categories listed on WMF website (www.wood.ie/wood-awards-ireland) with details:

- 1. Large-scale public buildings
- 2. Small-scale private
- 3. Restoration and conservation
- 4. Structural
- **5.** Furniture –bespoke and production
- **6.** Other innovative functional and non functional projects .

In addition to completing form application form please submit between three and six photos of work (not less than 1,800KB each), copies of drawings and illustrations..

Each entry will require a separate application.

Eligible projects must be completed during the period 1 June 2012 to 30 June 2014 (we are allowing a wide time span for projects as this is the inaugural awards).

Judging panel will shortlist entries and visit these projects in Ireland. Notice will be given of visits and where possible applicant should be present.

Short listed international projects will be judged on the basis of submission but additional material including videos or YouTube links will be accepted.
